ow deep is God's love for us? Could it be measured?

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." Do you still have any reason to question God's love for you? God's love is deep and broad and wide. It cannot be measured, it cannot be controlled, and it cannot fail. My brothers and sisters in Christ, all of us have experienced God's love at various points in our lives. It may not be readily absorbed by those who do not fully trust him, but know this; God holds us when we are weak; he guides us when we are perplexed; he loves us at our worst, and is with us when everyone else gives us up. Have you ever been in trouble so deep that you thought you would never get out and then suddenly, you felt relief? It's like the song-writer said, "I was sinking deep in sin, far from the peaceful shore, very deeply stained with sin sinking to rise no more, then the master of the sea, heard my despairing cry, and from the waters lifted me now safe am I. Love lifted me, love lifted me, when nothing else could help, love lifted me." God is that love that lifted you! Most times when we lose our way, we are too ashamed to call on God, and as a result have no power to help ourselves and continue to fall. But, know that God's love shines brightest in our darkest hours, his saving hand is longest when we sinking at our lowest, that God's mercy for us is ever sure when we are most doubtful. God's love will always lift us up, but we must acknowledge him; call on him and he will answer us in times of trouble.

All of us know how it feels to be rejected. In our quest to experience love, to fill the void in our hearts, we are constantly making other people our priority when they only see us as opportunity. That void will never be filled if we keep getting our priorities mixed up, if we keep looking for love in the wrong places. Put God first. He can fill the emptiness inside of you. God's love for us never changes. His love for us is steadfast. Where have you been looking? How many times have you been rejected? If you really want to find genuine love, Jesus is the answer. He has great plans for you. He will use you in his service not for gain but for profit. When we are being used by others we feel exploited, but when we are used by God we feel liberated. Many people who complain of being lonely and are well, need to be in the service of the Lord; and sometimes, even when we are unwell, God can still use us to be a blessing to someone else. When we learn to prioritize, God will intervene and open doors of opportunities for us. God is able to use the little that we have for good. Too many times we are at our lowest and it seems like at that moment there comes someone who is a point below. Many times we are complaining that we are down to our last dollar, when someone else has not seen a dollar in a long time. Too often we lament about our sickness that is curable, when someone has just been given a month to live. My brothers and sisters in Christ, there is no void in your heart and mine that God is not able to fill. There is no door that God can open that man will be able to close. We need to trust God more. We need to give God more opportunity. We need to rely on his faithfulness. We need to stop getting our priorities mixed up; because, despite what we may think, we are all top priority in God's eyes. hy do we love? We love because God first loved us. 1 John 4:19

If anyone says, "I love God," but hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. Lord, allow your love to change me. If I have been unlovely, change me, so that others could see you in me; so that others could experience your love through me. I want to be lovely always, so please, empty me of all that is unworthy, and fill my life anew with your love that has no limit or measure. Lord, many times our love comes with conditions, we hold others hostage, but teach us to love like you do, without conditions. When we are tempted to be unlovely towards others, send us gentle reminders of how unlovely we have been, yet, you did not withhold your love from us. Some of us are ashamed or afraid to claim God's love because of the many times that we have failed; but know that Psalm 23:64 says; surely your unfailing love will pursue me all the days of my life. No matter how far we run or hide from God's love, it will pursue us, because it is God's will. He loves us too much to turn his back on us. And, if God so loves us, we should try to love one another and not be so quick to judge or give up on one another. We get angry, we hold grudges, and we even act spitefully towards those we claim to love. Does God treat us this way? He could, but he does not. We are so deserving of his wrath but he is merciful, so, let us learn to love one another as God love us. God's love is big, God's love is bold, and it's ours to have and to hold and to share.

ow I prepare myself to celebrate the joyous Easter.

I find myself praying more purposefully during Lent. It seems like I am more repentant, more mindful of the cross, more in touch with my God during this time. It seems like every sin I have committed stands out before me during Lent, and I am thankful for this Season in which I seek spiritual cleansing. I use this time to self-examine, to repent by praying and fasting, by self- denial and by reading and meditating on God's word. My favorite prayer during this time is Psalm 51, the Psalm of David. I repeatedly ask God to be merciful to me, to create in me a clean heart and to renew a right spirit within me. During Lent, I find that my temptations are greater. I have to be always on guard as the enemy attacks me in the same areas. But, God is good, he promised that he would not allow us to be tempted beyond what we can bear, and he always provides a way out, we just need to take it. The night before Easter Sunday, Holy Saturday, I light white candles around the house and enjoy a quiet Easter Vigil in preparation for Easter when I will renew my Baptismal Covenant. When Easter Sunday comes around and the church is packed, the choir is at its best, the Easter songs, the incense burning, the altar decked out with white Easter lilies, all set the stage for a glorious Easter. When I say, the Lord is risen indeed, I believe that he is risen in my pure heart.


