

Do not dwell on what you have lost, but begin anew and see what God will do for you.


Time spent with God should never be an obligation, but a time for joyful oblation. Take time to pray.

Time spent with meaningless pastimes could be better spent with God. Choose!


I will begin the journey with God today and give him the glory, honor and praise all the way, all the day.
