nd he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what will you have me to do?

Are you courageous enough to ask God this question? To be able to boldly ask God for directions one needs to be bold and courageous and sometimes fearful. When Saul asked God this question many would say he asked out of fear, because Saul was busy trying to destroy the church, going from house to house, dragging men and women and putting them in prison; and just like when we too are doing wrong, the Lord steps in and blocks our path to destruction and sometimes he redirects us. Saul was redirected, God caused him to see again after blinding him for three days and to be filled with the Holy Spirit; and trembling and astonished he said, Lord, what will you have me to do? He was empowered by God who said to him, "Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told you what you must do. Many times like Saul, God will need to blind us to our faults so that we would serve Him. Many times, we are so busy grieving the Holy Spirit, we are so busy tearing down God's church and God's people; but, how long, how long will our good Lord, stand idly by and watch us destroy what he has built? Saul needed to come to himself, he needed to be made aware that what he was doing was abominable in God's eyes. Saul had seeing eyes but he could not see, so God blinded him for three days so that he would come to himself and when he did, Saul submitted without reserve, desirous to know what the Lord Jesus would have him to do. Would the good Lord have to blind you also for three days for you to come to yourself and acknowledge God? Would you be as courageous as Saul and submissive to do His will?

Is anything too difficult for God? At the appointed time I will return to you, at this time next year, and Sarah will have a son." Romans 4:21 Abraham did not waver through disbelief in the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God was able to do what He had promised. How many of us could say we have such faith as Abraham to believe in what seemed impossible? We are all waiting for one promise or the other from God and waiting is hard for a believer and even harder for an unbeliever. But as we as believers grow in our faith, as we study God's promises that he made to the children of Israel and that were manifested, we have more reason to hold on to his promises to us, that what he said he would do would come to pass. For everything that was written in the past was written for our instruction, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures, we might have hope. We must strive more to be more like Abraham. "He did not waver through disbelief in the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God was able to do what He had promised. That is why "it was credited to him as righteousness and it was not for Abraham's credit alone, but also for us, to whom righteousness will be credited—for us who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead for our trespasses and was raised to life for our justification." Praise the Lord! There is nothing too difficult for the Lord. Whatever he says he will do he will but in his own timing, we must learn to wait patiently on the Lord.


