The message of the cross is foolish to those who are headed for destruction. as your veil been lifted? I was blind but now I can see and I thank God for saving me.

"If the Good News we preach is hidden behind a veil, it is hidden only from people who are perishing. But whenever someone believes and turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away". My brothers and sisters in Christ, when the Lord showed us the light of his countenance, we were changed, we became a new creation, we were born again. But, it was a process, we too were also veiled, we did not understand with fear, our responsibility to the Lord, we were walking in darkness, but, now we are persuaded, we believe in the risen and ascended Lord, and our veil has been lifted. Now, our responsibility is to persuade others, that, anyone who claims Jesus Christ as Lord, and believes that he will come again, and repents, will become a new person. od will take life's pieces and give us unbroken peace. Are you ready to be healed?

What have you been through that has crushed you, and all you now see are broken pieces of yourself? Life throws us curveballs. Sometimes we experience hardships because of the decisions that we have made, and other times, they are God's way of getting our attention, and sometimes it's because we are under attack from the enemy. In my life experiences, whenever things are going well, I am happy, but cautiously happy; and the reason is not because I am not trusting of the source of my happiness, but I know all too well, that the enemy is lurking around me, to cause me unhappiness, because his job is to rob and steal our joy. My brothers and sisters in Christ, where you see yourself now as broken, believe that our God is a master potter, who could make everything new and whole again. God is able to take the broken pieces of your life and give you unbroken peace; but, you have to trust him, you have to believe; for God wants us to be happy, he wants us to live the abundant life in him. His will is not for us to suffer, but for us to have happy hearts to praise him. Too many of us get discouraged, we lose hope in God when we are going through crushing situations, we feel broken beyond repair, and we get trapped in despair, because sometimes, the situations have imprisoned us, we shut everyone out especially God, who is able to help us. But, I am encouraging you, to never allow yourself to become so hopelessly discouraged, because you then give the devil opportunity. When we are too wrapped up in our situation, we lock out the comforter and block our healing. But, understand this, the situation that you are going through is not bigger or stronger than God, he brought you through storms before and he could do it again. When you are faced with a situation that seems broken beyond repair, take courage in Psalm 43: 4. The Psalmist David was troubled, he believed that God had rejected him, but, he also knew deep down, that, God was the only one who could help him, so he prayed this prayer: "Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I trust you, Lord! And I will praise you again, because you help me, and you are my God. Then, I will go to the altar of God, to God, the source of all my joy. I will praise you with my harp, O God, my God".

as the Lord changed your name? Genesis 17:1

When Abram was 99 years old, the Lord appeared to him, saying, "I am God Almighty. Live in My presence and be blameless, that I may make My covenant between me and you, and may multiply you greatly. No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham". When I read this passage of scripture, it fills me with hope, and trust in God. It reminds me that no matter how old I am, that God could still use me. It encourages me to live in his presence, and to trust God faithfully, because there are great benefits to serving the Lord blamelessly, and it also reassures me, that no matter what others call me, that God can change my name to suit his purpose. My brothers and sisters in Christ, how old are you? What is your name? Are you willing to live in God's presence and be blameless before him? Are you ready for God to multiply you greatly? If you are willing, God will prepare you and make you fit for his purpose. But, you must be faithful, you must walk blamelessly before him, you must acknowledge him as your God and live daily in his presence. I cannot begin to tell you just how awesome my life has been since Jesus changed my name. I don't worry about what others call me, because I know my Master's voice and when he calls I answer. God has a plan and a purpose for all of us. And, in the right time, he will change our name and reveal his plans for us. So, let us learn to live in God's presence. "What's more, I am changing your name. It will no longer be Abram. Instead, you will be called Abraham, for you will be the father of many nations".

"For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness, and rivers in the desert". Look around you and within you, and see what God has already done for you and give him the glory. God is just getting started.


