ow do you know if you are called by God? Is there a special sign or sound?

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose — Romans chapter eight verse twenty eight. It may seem like we are always hearing someone else talk about their purpose in life, while we are still trying to find out our own purpose in life. But my friends, this is not something you have to find out on your own, in due time God will reveal his purpose for your life, because he already knows the beginning and the end. He calls us according to his purpose. Just continue to love him, to do all things that will bring him glory and praise, and God will begin to use you according to his purpose when the time is right. You know, when we read this verse from Romans chapter eight, we may have put it to mean many things; but for me, I have come to truly understand how this could happen, I have seen how this works, I understand what it means to love God, and to have him use me according to his purpose. My brothers and sisters in Christ, I am not perfect, this does not mean that I love God, and that I am always doing what is right, or saying what is right; but I know that to love God, is to know of his love and to make his love known; that is my purpose, that is what God has called me to do, and every day I find avenues, I look for opportunities to make his love known, and I could tell you, that this is rewarding. Just to give you and example of how God uses me according to his purpose, and positions me to make his love known; the other day I had a representative from a utility company in my home, and one of the first things he said to me was, "I love your home, I sense peace in your home", and my response to him was, "In a home where God abides, he blesses it with his peace, and that God not only abides in my home, he abides in my heart." He went on to say, "From the moment I entered your home and the way you greeted me, I sensed that there was something different about you." That, was my cue to allow God to use me according to his purpose. After speaking with him for a few minutes, telling him how God has blessed me and my ministry, he was curious enough to ask me how I got started. We had a wonderful discussion, where I told him about how reluctant I was to follow God, and how when God started using me for his service I was in denial, as I could not believe the changes he brought to my life; the work he began in me. in turn, I learned about him and where he was in his walk with God, and I was able to provide him with some spiritual guidance that he said he so desperately needed. We are now connected, and I have offered to help to support him on his spiritual journey. So too, you will have opportunities to tell others of where God brought you from, to tell others that because you have been on a spiritual journey with your God, he has been using you according to his purpose. You will know when you are called by God, when you begin to walk a path that you could not have imagined, and the more you walk the easier it becomes, or you could distinctly hear God's voice calling you to his service and going the other way, but keep ending up at the same place, or in some instances, the way is long and hard, but God makes it all possible. My brothers and sisters in Christ, allow others to see the difference in you, allow God to use you to make his love known to others, no matter where you are. God will use people, people like you and me who love him, who are the called according to his purpose, and all things will work together for our good. Nothing that we go through is a mistake, there is a lesson to be learned, there is a story to share, or to help others who are lagging in the faith or to encourage someone who just needs a reason to believe.

o you get tired of the waiting on God? God knows our patience level – WAIT!

My brothers and sisters in Christ, our god is an on-time God. He knows our needs before we ask, he knows us more than we know ourselves, because he determined our patience threshold long before we were born, therefore, be patient. Many times our wait seems long, because of the plans that we make before consulting God. Maybe what we wanted seemed right in our own eyes, but was not something that God intended for us to have; and because the wait seemed too long, we made a decision on our own, to get it anyway, and before long, we realized that the decision we made did not bring us the result we wanted; then, what do we do, we come running back to God, crying out to him. But, we need to understand, that, God sees every teardrop that fall from our eyes, he knows our needs before we ask, and he hears and answer us when we call; we just need to trust him, to make our requests known to him, and be patient. We must never place our trust in God, then go back and try to take control. Proverbs chapter sixteen and verse one reminds us, that, the plans of the heart belong to man, but the answer of the tongue is from the Lord. We can make our own plans, but the Lord gives the right answer at the right time. Do you happen to notice that when you have been waiting on God and the breakthrough is close that more problems arise? I now understand, that when this happens, it's not a time to begin to doubt God, as many of us do, but the perfect opportunity to praise God.

he Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives. Do you believe this?

Many of us who are saved, at some point, have questioned this very popular verse of scripture from Psalm thirtyseven; because, while we have been serving God faithfully, we find ourselves in some situations that we believe could not have been a result of God being delighted with us. But, are we right in assuming this? Certainly not! As a matter of fact, it's because the Lord delights in us, because he knows what we are capable of when we go through the storms of life; and as we grow more in the knowledge of him, the less we would question God's actions. God delights in every detail of our lives. At times it may not look this way, but we should understand, that, if we know how to accept the good things that the Lord has given us, when troubled times come, we should be strong enough in the faith, to trust God for favorable outcomes. All of our steps are ordered by the Lord, so there is no way that we could understand our own way, and there is no reason why we should question his actions. That is why he reminds us, that, we should at all times, and in all our ways, acknowledge Him, and he will make our paths straight. My brothers and sisters in Christ, if we do what the Lord wants, he will make certain each step we take is sure, even when to us, the steps seem unsure. Just the other day I was talking to someone who has been going through a lot of problems physically, and I was so impressed when she said to me, "I have been dealing with a lot, but I have learned to praise God in the midst of it all." My brothers and sisters in Christ, this is the right attitude to have. Let us turn our pain into praise, our heartaches into hallelujahs, and our temptations into shouts of triumph, because He that is with us, is much more stronger than the forces against us; and if do not lose heart we will be victorious. Praise the Lord!

We are reminded in first Timothy chapter six, that we brought nothing into this world, so that we can take nothing out of it, and that if we have food and clothing that this should be enough. 
